1 Peter 1:18 What were you? Ransomed

1 Peter 1:18 From what were you ransomed? The futile ways inherited from your forefathers

1 Peter 1:18 With what were you not ransomed? Perishable things such as silver or gold

1 Peter 1:20 What was he? Foreknown **OR** Made manifest

1 Peter 1:20 Before what was he foreknown? The foundation of the world

1 Peter 1:20 In when was he made manifest? The last times

1 Peter 1:20 Why was he made manifest (in the last times)? For the sake of you

1 Peter 1:21 What are in God? Your faith and hope

1 Peter 1:21 In whom are your faith and hope? God

1 Peter 1:22 Love whom? One another

1 Peter 1:22 How love one another? Earnestly **OR** having purified your souls by your obedience to the truth for a sincere brotherly love

1 Peter 1:22 From what love one another? A pure heart

1 Peter 1:23 What have you been? Born again

1 Peter 1:23 Of what have you been born again? Not of perishable seed but of imperishable

1 Peter 1:23 Through what have you been born again? The living and abiding word of God

1 Peter 1:24 What is like grass [**OR** Who is like grass]? All flesh

1 Peter 1:24 Like what is all flesh [**OR** What withers]? Grass

1 Peter 1:24 What is like the flower of grass? All its glory

1 Peter 1:24 Like what is all its glory [**OR** What falls]? The flower (of grass)

1 Peter 1:25 What remains forever [**OR** What is the good news that was preached to you]? The word of the Lord **OR** This word

1 Peter 1:25 When does the word of the Lord remain? Forever

1 Peter 2:1 What put away? All malice and all deceit and hypocrisy and envy and all slander

1 Peter 2:2 Like whom, long for the pure spiritual milk? Newborn infants

1 Peter 2:2 For what long [**OR** By what may you grow up into salvation]? (It,) The pure spiritual milk

1 Peter 2:2 Why long for the pure spiritual milk? That by it you may grow up into salvation

1 Peter 2:2 Into what may you grow up? Salvation

1 Peter 2:3 Who is good? The Lord

1 Peter 2:3 What is the Lord? Good

1 Peter 2:5 Who are being built up? You yourselves

1 Peter 2:5 Like what are you yourselves being built up? Living stones

1 Peter 2:5 As what are you yourselves being built up? A spiritual house

1 Peter 2:5 Why are you yourselves being built up? To be a holy priesthood **OR** To offer spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ

1 Peter 2:6 In what does it stand? Scripture

1 Peter 2:6 What stands in Scripture? (It,) Behold, I am laying in Zion a stone, a cornerstone chosen and precious, and whoever believes in him will not be put to shame

1 Peter 2:6 In where am I laying a stone? Zion

1 Peter 2:6 What am I laying (in Zion)? A stone **OR** A cornerstone chosen and precious

1 Peter 2:6 Who will not be put to shame? Whoever believes in him

1 Peter 2:6 To what will whoever believes in him not be put? Shame

1 Peter 2:7 What is for you who believe? The honor

1 Peter 2:7 For whom is the honor? You who believe

1 Peter 2:7 For whom has the stone that the builders rejected become the cornerstone? Those who do not believe

1 Peter 2:7 What has become the cornerstone? The stone that the builders rejected

1 Peter 2:8 Why do they stumble? Because they disobey the word

1 Peter 2:8 What do they disobey? The word

1 Peter 2:8 How do they disobey the word? As they were destined to do

1 Peter 2:9 Who are you [**OR** What are you]? A chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession

1 Peter 2:9 Why are you a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession? That you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you

1 Peter 2:9 What may you proclaim? The excellencies of him who called you

1 Peter 2:10 When were you not a people [**OR** When had you not received mercy]? Once

1 Peter 2:10 When are you God's people [**OR** When have you received mercy]? Now

1 Peter 2:10 Who were you not [**OR** What were you not]? A people

1 Peter 2:10 Who are you (now)? God's people

1 Peter 2:10 What had you not received [**OR** What have you received now]? Mercy

1 Peter 2:11 As whom do I urge you **OR** As what do I urge you]? Sojourners and exiles

1 Peter 2:11 From what do I urge you to abstain [**OR** What war against your soul]? The passions of the flesh

1 Peter 2:12 Keep what honorable? Your conduct

1 Peter 2:12 Among whom keep your conduct honorable? The Gentiles

1 Peter 2:12 Why keep your conduct among the Gentiles honorable? So that when they speak against you as evildoers, they may see your good deeds and glorify God on the day of visitation

1 Peter 2:12 When may they see your good deeds? When they speak against you as evildoers

1 Peter 2:12 What may they see? Your good deeds

1 Peter 2:12 Whom may they glorify? God

1 Peter 2:12 On when may they glorify God? The day of visitation

1 Peter 2:13 Be what (to every human institution)? Subject

1 Peter 2:13 Why be subject (to every human institution)? For the Lord's sake

1 Peter 2:13 To what be subject (for the Lord's sake)? Every human institution

1 Peter 2:15 What is the will of God? (This,) That by doing good you should put to silence the ignorance of foolish people

1 Peter 2:15 To what should you put the ignorance of foolish people? Silence

1 Peter 2:15 Of whom is this the will? God

1 Peter 2:15 By what should you put to silence the ignorance of foolish people? Doing good

1 Peter 2:16 How live? As people who are free **OR** Not using your freedom as a cover-up for evil, but living as servants of God

1 Peter 2:17 Honor whom? Everyone **OR** The emperor

1 Peter 2:17 Love whom? The brotherhood

1 Peter 2:17 Fear whom? God

1 Peter 2:18 Who be subject? Servants

1 Peter 2:18 Be what (servants)? Subject

1 Peter 2:18 To whom be subject (servants)? Your masters **OR** Not only to the good and gentle but also to the unjust

1 Peter 2:18 With what be subject (servants)? All respect

1 Peter 2:19 What is a gracious thing? (This,) When, mindful of God, one endures sorrows while suffering unjustly

1 Peter 2:20 If what is this a gracious thing? If when you do good and suffer for it you endure

1 Peter 2:20 What is this, if when you do good and suffer for it you endure? A gracious thing

1 Peter 2:20 In what is this a gracious thing, if when you do good and suffer for it you endure? The sight of God

1 Peter 2:21 What have you been? Called (to this)

1 Peter 2:21 Why have you been called to this? Because Christ also suffered for you

1 Peter 2:21 Who suffered (also)? Christ

1 Peter 2:22 What did he commit? No sin

1 Peter 2:23 When did he not revile in return? When he was reviled

1 Peter 2:23 What was he? Reviled

1 Peter 2:23 When did he not threaten? When he suffered

1 Peter 2:24 Who bore our sins? He himself

1 Peter 2:24 What did he himself bear? Our sins

1 Peter 2:24 In what did he himself bear our sins? His body

1 Peter 2:24 On what did he himself bear our sins? The tree

1 Peter 2:24 Why did he himself bear our sins in his body on the tree? That we might die to

sin and live to righteousness

1 Peter 2:25

Like what were you straying? Sheep

1 Peter 2:25

To whom have you returned? The Shepherd and Overseer of your souls

1 Peter 3:1 Who be subject (to your own husbands)? Wives

1 Peter 3:1 Be what (wives)? Subject

1 Peter 3:1 To whom be subject (wives)? Your own husbands

1 Peter 3:1 Why be subject to your own husbands (wives)? So that even if some do not obey the word, they may be won without a word by the conduct of their wives

1 Peter 3:1 Without what may they be won? A word

1 Peter 3:1 By what may they be won? The conduct of their wives

1 Peter 3:3 What do not let your adorning be? External **OR** The braiding of hair and the putting on of gold jewelry, or the clothing you wear

1 Peter 3:4 Let what be the hidden person of the heart? Your adorning

1 Peter 3:4 With what let your adorning be the hidden person of the heart [**OR** What is very precious]? The imperishable beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit

1 Peter 3:5 What is this? How the holy women who hoped in God used to adorn themselves

1 Peter 3:5 Who used to adorn themselves? The holy women who hoped in God

1 Peter 3:6 Who obeyed Abraham? Sarah

1 Peter 3:6 Whom did Sarah obey? Abraham

1 Peter 3:6 How did Sarah obey Abraham? Calling him lord

1 Peter 3:6 Who are you, if you do good and do not fear anything that is frightening? Her children

1 Peter 3:6 If what are you her children? If you do good and do not fear anything that is frightening

1 Peter 3:7 Who live with your wives in an understanding way? Husbands

1 Peter 3:7 With whom live (husbands)? Your wives

1 Peter 3:7 How live with your wives (husbands)? In an understanding way **OR** Showing honor to the woman as the weaker vessel

1 Peter 3:7 Why live with your wives in an understanding way (husbands)? Since they are heirs with you of the grace of life **OR** So that your prayers may not be hindered

1 Peter 3:7 Who are they [**OR** What are they]? Heirs of the grace of life (with you)

1 Peter 3:7 Of what are they heirs (with you)? The grace of life

1 Peter 3:7 What may your prayers not be? Hindered

1 Peter 3:8 Have what? Unity of mind, sympathy, brotherly love, a tender heart, and a humble mind

1 Peter 3:9 What do not repay? Evil (for evil) **OR** Reviling (for reviling)

1 Peter 3:9 Why bless? For to this you were called **OR** That you may obtain a blessing

1 Peter 3:9 What were you? Called (to this)

1 Peter 3:10 What let him keep from evil? His tongue

1 Peter 3:10 From what let him keep his tongue? Evil

1 Peter 3:11 From what let him turn away? Evil

1 Peter 3:11 What let him seek (and pursue)? Peace

1 Peter 3:12 What are on the righteous? The eyes of the Lord

1 Peter 3:12 On whom are the eyes of the Lord? The righteous

1 Peter 3:12 What are open (to their prayer)? His ears

1 Peter 3:12 To what are his ears open? Their prayer

1 Peter 3:12 What is against those who do evil? The face of the Lord  
 1 Peter 3:12 Against whom is the face of the Lord? Those who do evil  
 1 Peter 3:14 If what will you be blessed? (Even if) You should suffer for righteousness' sake  
 1 Peter 3:14 What will you be, even if you should suffer for righteousness' sake? Blessed  
 1 Peter 3:14 Have what? No fear of them  
 1 Peter 3:15 In what honor Christ the Lord as holy? Your hearts  
 1 Peter 3:15 Honor whom (as holy)? Christ the Lord

1 Peter 3:15 How honor Christ the Lord? As holy **OR** Always being prepared to make a  
 defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you  
 1 Peter 3:15 With what do it? Gentleness and respect  
 1 Peter 3:16 When may those who revile your good behavior in Christ be put to shame?  
 When you are slandered  
 1 Peter 3:16 Who may be put to shame? Those who revile your good behavior in Christ  
 1 Peter 3:16 To what may those who revile your good behavior in Christ be put? Shame  
 1 Peter 3:17 What is better? (It,) To suffer for doing good, if that should be God's will, than for  
 doing evil  
 1 Peter 3:17 If what is it better to suffer for doing good than for doing evil? If that should be  
 God's will  
 1 Peter 3:17 For what is it better to suffer, if that should be God's will? (For) Doing good than  
 for doing evil  
 1 Peter 3:18 Who suffered (also)? Christ  
 1 Peter 3:18 When did Christ suffer (also)? Once  
 1 Peter 3:18 For what did Christ suffer (also)? Sins  
 1 Peter 3:18 Why did Christ suffer once for sins? That he might bring us to God  
 1 Peter 3:18 How did Christ suffer for sins? Being put to death in the flesh but made alive in  
 the spirit **OR** The righteous for the unrighteous  
 1 Peter 3:20 When did they not obey [**OR** How did they not obey]? Formerly **OR** When God's  
 patience waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was being prepared  
 1 Peter 3:20 What waited? God's patience  
 1 Peter 3:20 In when did God's patience wait? The days of Noah  
 1 Peter 3:20 What was being prepared [**OR** In what were a few brought safely]? The ark  
 1 Peter 3:20 Who were brought safely (through water)? A few, that is, eight persons  
 1 Peter 3:20 How were a few brought (that is, eight persons)? Safely  
 1 Peter 3:20 Through what were a few brought (that is, eight persons)? Water  
 1 Peter 3:21 What corresponds to this [**OR** What now saves you]? Baptism  
 1 Peter 3:21 How does baptism now save you? Not as a removal of dirt from the body but as  
 an appeal to God for a good conscience, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ

1 Peter 4:1 Why arm yourselves with the same way of thinking? Since therefore Christ suffered in the flesh **OR** For whoever has suffered in the flesh has ceased from sin

1 Peter 4:1 Who suffered (in the flesh)? Christ

1 Peter 4:1 In what did Christ suffer? The flesh

1 Peter 4:1 With what arm yourselves? The same way of thinking

1 Peter 4:1 Who has ceased from sin? Whoever has suffered in the flesh

1 Peter 4:1 From what has whoever has suffered in the flesh ceased? Sin

1 Peter 4:3 When suffices [**OR** What suffices]? The time that is past

1 Peter 4:3 For what does the time that is past suffice? Doing what the Gentiles want to do **OR** Living in sensuality, passions, drunkenness, orgies, drinking parties, and lawless idolatry

1 Peter 4:4 With what are they surprised when you do not join them? Respect to this

1 Peter 4:4 What are they? Surprised

1 Peter 4:4 When are they surprised? When you do not join them

1 Peter 4:4 In what do you not join them? The same flood of debauchery

1 Peter 4:5 What will they give? Account

1 Peter 4:5 To whom will they give account? Him who is ready to judge the living and the dead

1 Peter 4:6 Why was the gospel preached even to those who are dead? That though judged in the flesh the way people are, they might live in the spirit the way God does **OR** This is why

1 Peter 4:6 What was preached? The gospel

1 Peter 4:6 To whom was the gospel preached? (Even to) Those who are dead

1 Peter 4:6 How might they live? The way God does **OR** In the spirit

1 Peter 4:7 What is at hand? The end of all things

1 Peter 4:7 At what is the end of all things? Hand

1 Peter 4:7 Why be self-controlled and sober-minded? For the sake of your prayers **OR** The end of all things is at hand

1 Peter 4:7 Be what? Self-controlled and sober-minded

1 Peter 4:8 Whom keep loving? One another

1 Peter 4:8 How keep loving one another? Earnestly

1 Peter 4:8 Why keep loving one another earnestly? Since love covers a multitude of sins

1 Peter 4:8 What covers a multitude of sins? Love

1 Peter 4:9 Show what? Hospitality

1 Peter 4:9 To whom show hospitality? One another

1 Peter 4:9 Without what show hospitality? Grumbling

1 Peter 4:10 Who has received a gift? Each

1 Peter 4:10 What has each received? A gift

1 Peter 4:10 Why use it? To serve one another

1 Peter 4:10 As what use it to serve one another? Good stewards of God's varied grace **OR** As each has received a gift

1 Peter 4:11 Who may be glorified? God



1 Peter 4:11 What may God be? Glorified  
 1 Peter 4:11 In what may God be glorified? Everything  
 1 Peter 4:11 Through whom may God be glorified? Jesus Christ  
 1 Peter 4:11 What belong to him? Glory and dominion  
 1 Peter 4:11 When do glory and dominion belong to him? Forever and ever  
 1 Peter 4:12 What do not be? Surprised  
 1 Peter 4:12 At what do not be surprised? The fiery trial  
 1 Peter 4:12 When do not be surprised at the fiery trial? When it comes upon you to test you

 As though something strange were happening to you  
 1 Peter 4:12 Why does it come upon you [**OR** Why does the fiery trial come upon you]? To  
 test you  
 1 Peter 4:13 Why rejoice? That you may also rejoice and be glad when his glory is revealed  
 1 Peter 4:13 What do you share? Christ's sufferings  
 1 Peter 4:13 When may you rejoice and be glad (also)? When his glory is revealed  
 1 Peter 4:14 If what are you blessed? If you are insulted for the name of Christ  
 1 Peter 4:14 What are you, if you are insulted for the name of Christ? Blessed  
 1 Peter 4:14 Why are you blessed if you are insulted for the name of Christ? Because the  
 Spirit of glory and of God rests upon you  
 1 Peter 4:14 Who rests upon you? The Spirit of glory and of God  
 1 Peter 4:15 Let whom suffer as a murderer or a thief or an evildoer or as a meddler? None of  
 you  
 1 Peter 4:15 As whom let none of you suffer? A murderer or a thief or an evildoer or (as) a  
 meddler  
 1 Peter 4:16 If what let him not be ashamed? If anyone suffers as a Christian  
 1 Peter 4:16 What let him not be, if anyone suffers as a Christian? Ashamed  
 1 Peter 4:16 Whom let him glorify? God  
 1 Peter 4:16 In what let him glorify God? That name  
 1 Peter 4:19 Let whom entrust their souls to a faithful Creator while doing good? Those who  
 suffer according to God's will  
 1 Peter 4:19 What let those who suffer according to God's will entrust? Their souls (to a  
 faithful Creator)  
 1 Peter 4:19 To whom let those who suffer according to God's will entrust their souls? A  
 faithful Creator  
 1 Peter 4:19 When let those who suffer according to God's will entrust their souls to a faithful  
 Creator? While doing good

1 Peter 5:1 Whom do I exhort? The elders among you

1 Peter 5:1 As whom do I exhort the elders among you? A fellow elder and a witness of the sufferings of Christ **OR** A partaker in the glory that is going to be revealed

1 Peter 5:2 Shepherd what? The flock of God that is among you

1 Peter 5:2 How shepherd the flock of God that is among you? Exercising oversight **OR** Not under compulsion, but willingly **OR** As God would have you **OR** Not for shameful gain, but eagerly

1 Peter 5:4 When will you receive the unfading crown of glory? When the chief Shepherd appears

1 Peter 5:4 What will you receive? The unfading crown of glory

1 Peter 5:5 Who be subject (to the elders)? You who are younger

1 Peter 5:5 To whom be subject? The elders

1 Peter 5:5 Be what? Subject (to the elders)

1 Peter 5:5 Clothe whom? Yourselves, all of you

1 Peter 5:5 With what clothe yourselves? Humility

1 Peter 5:5 Why clothe yourselves with humility toward one another? For, God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble

1 Peter 5:5 Who opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble? God

1 Peter 5:5 Whom does God oppose? The proud

1 Peter 5:5 To whom does God give grace? The humble

1 Peter 5:5 What does God give to the humble? Grace

1 Peter 5:6 Under what humble yourselves? The mighty hand of God

1 Peter 5:6 Why humble yourselves (under the mighty hand of God)? So that at the proper time he may exalt you

1 Peter 5:6 At when may he exalt you? The proper time

1 Peter 5:8 Be what? Sober minded **OR** Watchful

1 Peter 5:8 Who prowls around like a roaring lion? Your adversary the devil

1 Peter 5:8 Like what does your adversary the devil prowl around? A roaring lion

1 Peter 5:9 How resist him? Firm in your faith **OR** Knowing that the same kinds of suffering are being experienced by your brotherhood throughout the world

1 Peter 5:9 What are being experienced (by your brotherhood)? The same kinds of suffering

1 Peter 5:9 By whom are the same kinds of suffering being experienced? Your brotherhood

1 Peter 5:9 Throughout where are the same kinds of suffering being experienced by your brotherhood? The world

1 Peter 5:10 After when will the God of all grace restore, confirm, strengthen, and establish you? (After) You have suffered a little while

1 Peter 5:10 Who will restore, confirm, strengthen, and establish you [**OR** Who has called you to his eternal glory in Christ]? The God of all grace

1 Peter 5:10 To what has the God of all grace called you? His eternal glory in Christ

1 Peter 5:10 In whom has the God of all grace called you to his eternal glory? Christ

1 Peter 5:12 By whom have I written briefly? Silvanus

1 Peter 5:12 How have I written? Briefly **OR** Exhorting and declaring that this is the true grace of God

1 Peter 5:12      What is this? The true grace of God  
1 Peter 5:13      Who sends you greetings [**OR** Who is likewise chosen]? She who is at Babylon  
                            (and so does Mark)  
1 Peter 5:13      What does she who is at Babylon send you? Greetings  
1 Peter 5:14      Greet whom? One another  
1 Peter 5:14      With what greet one another? The kiss of love
